It is really nice to welcome you to our house.



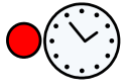

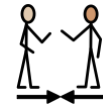
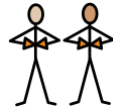
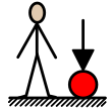
We want you to be safe. It is a good idea to think about who you tell about the house so

Your children's blankets and teddies









You will also go to our Therapy Centre. The team there can help with lots of other things too.



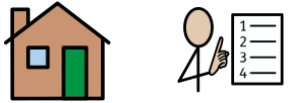
We have CCTV recording in the house. This is to keep everybody safe.

• Your child is your responsibility. Their safety is really important



• No smoking or vapping inside the house. Only in the areas outside where it says it is



allowed.



  
Who Do You Talk To?

We want to help you as soon as we can so we can make things better for your family

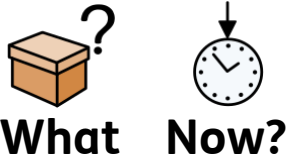
